

Hotline.ie Service provides an anonymous facility for Internet Users to report suspected illegal content, particularly Child Sexual Abuse Material, accidentally encountered Online, in a secure and confidential way.


Hotline.ie is run and funded by the Internet Service Providers Association of Ireland (ISPAI) whose members are determined to take measures to counter the use of their Internet facilities for such illegal purposes.

Hotline.ie has been working in collaboration with An Garda Síochána for 15 years to tackle online illegal content.

When Hotline.ie assesses reported material as illegal under Irish law, the location of the content is then traced, and if found to be hosted or distributed from Ireland, An Garda Síochána and the relevant ISPAI member are notified, so the material can be removed from public Internet access and law enforcement investigation may be initiated.

www.hotline.ie only deals with reports referring to suspected illegal content encountered on the Internet, while urgent situations where persons may be in immediate danger should always be reported to An Garda Síochána directly.
