RE: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000135-2017 **Partially Granted**

Dear Mr. Dineen,

I refer to your request, dated 28th March, 2017 and received on the 29th March 2017, which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered

Your request sought:

The amount of money spent by An Garda Síochána on media, communications and PR training in 2015, 2016 and 2017, to include the amount paid to the Communications Clinic for each of these years as well as the amount paid to other companies and individuals plus details of who they are.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to partially grant your request on the 24th April, 2017.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision.

A search of the financial management system was conducted at Finance Section, Garda Headquarters to identify the companies that were paid from the Garda Vote relating to public relations and media training services.

I advise that the expenditure on media and communication training by An Garda Síochána have been the subject of a number of requests under the FOI Act. An Garda Síochána, in keeping with section 8 of the FOI Act, maintains a list of decisions made on all non-personal requests, including the full decision letter on the Garda website (www.garda.ie), in the Freedom of Information section.

The following requests relate to your request:

I advise that I am refusing your request for “*money spent ... on media, communications and PR training in 2015, 2016*” pursuant to section 15(1)(d) and (i)(i) of the FOI Act, which states:

Refusal on administrative grounds to grant FOI requests

15. (1) A head to whom an FOI request is made may refuse to grant the request where
- (d) the information is already in the public domain,
 - (i) the request relates to records already released, either to the same or previous requester where –
 - (i) the records are available to the requester concerned, or

However, I am granting your request for “*money spent ... on media, communications and PR training in 2017...*”. I advise that the total payments made to the Communications Clinic, up to 31st March, 2017 is € 18,266.00.

1. Right of Appeal

The review will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of An Garda Síochána and the decision will be communicated to you within 3 weeks. The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances.
