#### 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision.

I am refusing your request pursuant to Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act which states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered. Your request is in relation to an operational policing matter which is outside the scope of the FOI Act insofar as it pertains to An Garda Síochána.
