

This information leaflet outlines the details of the forthcoming concerts in St Anne's Park on the June Bank Holiday Weekend.

**Kodaline** will headline on Friday May 31<sup>st</sup> and Saturday June 1<sup>st</sup>

**Nile Rodgers and Chic** will headline on Sunday June 2<sup>nd</sup>

Gates will open at **16.00** on each day and the concerts will finish at **22.45**.

We are expecting an older, more mature audience to attend these concerts.

Sound checks and tests will take place from 12.00 - 14.00 each day  
17.00 - 20:00 on Thursday May 30<sup>th</sup>.

There will be three entrances to the Concert site.

**GREEN** Entrance off Sybil Hill Road.

**BLUE** Entrance at the Tennis Courts on All Saints Road.

**RED** Entrance near the Botanical Gardens on All Saints Road.

Certain areas of the park will be closed to the public to facilitate the staging of the concerts. The attached map shows the closure areas and times. The main areas of the park will close at 14.00 on concert days. All Park carparks will close at 14.00 each day.

Concert patrons will arrive for the concert primarily on public transport with additional Dart services to and from the event. The designated station will be Harmonstown. Dublin Bus will enhance their services on each evening. A drop off and Pick up will be facilitated on James Larkin Road and the Causeway.

Liaison has taken place with Dublin City Council, An Garda Síochana, the HSE, Dublin Fire Service, Irish Rail and Dublin Bus over the last few months to ensure that a robust event management plan is in place and that the local neighbourhood is not disturbed by our event or our patrons.

Sybil Hill road from Vernon Ave to Howth Road will be closed each evening from 15.00 to 23.30 (access will be maintained for St Pauls College and Little Sisters of the Poor).

Temporary closures / diversions will occur post event depending on pedestrian numbers and will last a maximum of 1 Hour.

A combination of Gardai and stewards will be in position at the locations listed below from 15.00 each day to restrict access to Residents / Family members / Business owners or other persons with legitimate business within the area.

Olive's room will remain open as usual.

Gardai will have No Parking Cones in place along:

Mt Prospect Ave both ways, Blackheath Park both ways, Vernon Ave: from Seafield Road to Howth Road both ways, Vernon Ave: Castle Ave to Sybil Hill Road, Castle Ave. Howth Rd – Seafield road, both ways, Vernon Ave. Kincora rd – Clontarf Rd. – Restrictions where parking bays not provided, Clontarf Road – Green area along St Anne’s Park Wall, Watermill Road. Both ways where parking bays not provided, All Saints Road, Park Side only, Howth Road. Both Ways from Killester to Raheny, Brookwood Ave from Brookwood Road to Howth Rd, both ways, Harmonstown Rd, both ways including footpath on DART side, The Causeway, coned 150m in from James Larkin Road.

These will be in place from 07.00 Friday May 31<sup>st</sup> to 01.00 on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June

Howth Road: Furry Park Rd, Furry Park Road at Diamond, Dunluce Road

Watermill Road: Watermill Lawns, All Saints Road, Watermill Apartments / Bettyglen

Howth Road: The Meadows, Sybil Hill, All Saints Road, Cill Eanna, Ennafort Road

Brookwood Ave: Brookwood Pk, Brookwood Glen
