## Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000127-2023 Request Granted

#### Dear

I refer to your request, dated and clarified and received on 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

### Your request sought:

a record/database/spreadsheet of the number of days lost to illness by garda staff in 2022 in the following categories: flu/viral, mental health, musculoskeletal, not provided, other-please specify, post pregnancy, pregnancy related, surgery/post op, injury on duty: accident, injury on duty: RTA, malicious injury off duty, malicious injury on duty, occupational illness arising from duty, critical illness.

a record/database/spreadsheet of the number of days lost to illness by garda staff in total for 2022.

Clarified Request:

Both please. And if possible, if the figures could be provided separately.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on the 4<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

## 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Upon receipt, your request was forwarded to the relevant section of An Garda Síochána to retrieve the information requested by you and a number of records have been identified.

The tables below sets out the number of days lost to illness by Garda Members and Garda Staff in 2022.

Sickness absences are recorded and reported under the following categories – Ordinary Illness; Occupational Injury/Illness Arising from Duty and Critical Illness.
