Dear

I refer to your request, dated and received on 22nd April, 2020 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

A list of Garda Stations within Dublin that received maintenance works that was paid out the Garda Small Capital Works Programme in the years 2018, 2019 and to-date in 2020 in tabular form. Please indicate a brief description what works were carried out at each station. To be further assistance I am only seeking works that were carried out with funding from An Garda Siochana and not from the OPW.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on the 20th May, 2020.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Upon receipt, details of your request were forwarded to the Estate Management section of An Garda Síochána who conducted a search for records containing the information you have requested.

The Garda Small Capital Works budget funds elective works carried out in Garda Stations. The table below sets out the Garda stations, where small capital works were undertaken, with

a description of the works, where the cost of those works was charged to the Garda Vote in the period from 1 January 2018 to 31 March 2020.
