I refer to your request, dated 21st June, 2022 and received at this office on 30th June, 2022 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána. I further refer to the clarification of your request received at this office on the 5th July, 2022, accordingly your request has been amended and your request will commence from this date.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

Please provide us with all data relating to tenders and payments made in respect of vehicle towing and recovery in Louth, Meath and Monaghan.

We make this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2014.

Your clarified request sought:

We refer to previous correspondence and confirm the date renage for the documents we seek is the previous three years.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to part-grant your request on the 28th July 2022.

The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision.

Upon receipt, your request was forwarded to the relevant sections of An Garda Siochana where a search was conducted in respect of same and a number of records identified.

In relation to tenders for vehicle towing and recovery in Louth, Meath and Monaghan in the last 3 years I can advise that the Cavan/Monaghan contract commenced 21st March 2013. You can access this tender by following the link attached below;

I have been advised that there is no contract in place for the Meath Division. Therefore as the record does not exist I am refusing this part of your request in accordance with Section 15(1)(a) of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 which states:

Refusal on administrative grounds to grant FOI requests

15(1)(a) the record concerned does not exist or cannot be found after all reasonable steps to ascertain its whereabouts have been taken

Towing fees include all vehicles detained under Section 41 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, official Garda vehicles and other vehicles seized or transported by An Garda Síochána for investigative, evidential and technical examination purposes. These figures can include sums paid to non contracted firms who had been requested to remove a vehicle in an emergency situation or in cases where the location of the vehicle presented a danger to other road users and required immediate removal.

The table below details the amount paid by An Garda Síochána under the Towing subhead for Divisions Cavan/Monaghan, Louth and Meath for the years 2019, 2020 and 2021. These payments are made by An Garda Síochána to private companies for vehicle recovery and the division the cost was incurred. The Garda Divisions do not necessarily align the border and some Garda Divisions comprise of more than one county. In accordance with this geographical layout, figures are provided for Cavan/Monaghan Division and not specifically for Monaghan.
