I refer to your request, dated 20th July, 2022 and further clarified on 21st July, 2022 received on 22nd July, 2022 which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

a record/database/spreadsheet of the number of days lost to illness by garda staff in both 2020 and 2021 in the following categories: flu/viral, mental health, musculoskeletal, not provided, other-please specify, post pregnancy, pregnancy related, surgery/post op, injury on duty: accident, injury on duty: RTA, malicious injury off duty, malicious injury on duty, occupational illness arising from duty, critical illness. a record/database/spreadsheet of the number of days lost to illness by garda staff in total for each of 2020 and 2021.

Clarified Request:

This office seeks clarification on the records you are seeking. Can you please advise if the records sought are for Garda Staff or Garda Members.

Ideally, I would like both if it's possible to disaggregate them from each other. If only one were possible, it would be members I would be interested in primarily.

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on the 18th August 2022.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision.

1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Upon receipt your request was forwarded to the relevant sections of An Garda Síochána who have provided records to this Office in response to your request. I have been advised that Sickness absences are recorded and reported under the following categories — Critical Illness, Occupational Injury/Illness Arising from Duty and Ordinary Illness.
