## Re: Freedom of Information Request FOI-000402-2024 Request Granted

*Dear*

I refer to your request, dated and received on **2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2024** which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 (FOI Act) for records held by An Garda Síochána.

Part 1(n) of Schedule 1 of the FOI Act states that An Garda Síochána is listed as a partially included agency "*insofar as it relates to administrative records relating to human resources, or finance or procurement matters*". Therefore, only administrative records that relate to human resources, finance or procurement shall be considered.

Your request sought:

*I would like to make a FOI request under the Freedom of Information Act 2014. Under section 7 of this act, I would like access to the records held by An Garda Síochána to help with a safety assessment in my community on the R458 North of Gort Town. (Traffic Enforcement/Collision Zone 75)*

*The information I am seeking relates to road traffic enforcement fines related to 'speeding' for collision zones 75, 2297,1952 and 890 for years 2021, 2022, 2023.*

*I am seeking the total number of road traffic enforcement fines and the total amount of review per year, in excel (Preferred) or pdf format*

I wish to inform you that I have decided to grant your request on the 30<sup>th</sup> October 2024. The purpose of this letter is to explain my decision.

### 1. Findings, particulars and reasons for decision

Upon receipt your request was forwarded to the relevant Section of An Garda Síochána who have provided records to this office in response to your request.

The Garda National Roads Policing Bureau have advised that location co-ordinates are unavailable for speeding detections in relation to the locations detailed. Roads Policing have examined all fixed charge notices issued for speeding offences from 2021-2023 within the station area of Gort, County Galway where the R458 was within the location address.

Below is a yearly breakdown of the number of fixed charge notices issued for speeding offences at these locations:

2021	2022	2023
80	64	83

Below is a yearly breakdown of the revenue generated (€) from fixed charge notices issued for speeding offences:

Figures are based on incidents which occurred from 01/01/2021 to 31/12/2023, inclusive. All information contained in this report is based upon operational data from the FCPS system as was available on 21/10/2024 and is liable to change.

## 2. Right of Appeal
