



E-scooters

E-Scooters are a convenient mode of transport, but you have a duty of care to yourself & other road users. You also need to be sure that your e-scooter is road legal.

E-scooters are restricted to



A maximum weight unladen of 25 kilograms



A maximum design speed of 20 kilometres per hour



A maximum power of 400 W

E-scooters must have



Front and rear lights



A bell or horn



Front and rear brakes

E-scooters are not allowed



On footpaths or motorways



To carry passengers or goods



To have a seat

E-scooter users



Must be over 16 years old



Cannot use the scooter while intoxicated



Failure to adhere to Road Traffic legislation may incur a fine or a court summons.

Although personal protection equipment is not compulsory it is strongly recommended.

Together we can reduce serious and fatal road traffic collisions.
